





# TWO PUBLIC PERFORMANCES

\*If any musical program does not achieve the pre-arranged target number in registrations, MidAm International reserves the right to substitute an cappella or piano-accompanied concert at a residency location, allowing for 25 minutes of stage time, which is 20 minutes of music time.

## 1. The Main Gala concert on Wednesday, June 17 at Minoritenkirche, Vienna.

Guest conductors will lead 80-voice choirs in oratorios with KünstlerOrchesterWien.



## 2. Optional ensemble a capella spotlight concert on Friday, June 19 with their own conductors at Müllner Kirche, Salzburg.

Featuring 20 to 25 minute “a capella” (or accompanied by piano) performance scheduled for visiting choirs under their own conductors. A minimum of three groups must agree to do the a cappella solo performance before it can go forward.

# Austria Cultural Tours

## 1. VIENNA CITY TOUR AND SCHÖNBRUNN PALACE

See the most important sights of Vienna: the Hofburg Palace (the former winter residence of the Hapsburg family), the Ringstraße with its magnificent and impressive buildings such as the State Opera House, national museums, Parliament, the Burgtheater, the University and the Votivkirche; as well as the Karlskirche (Vienna's most beautiful baroque church) and the Musikverein, home of the Vienna Philharmonic Orchestra. The highlight of the tour will be an interior visit of the famous Schönbrunn Palace with its lavishly decorated rooms that demonstrate the glamor of past times. Schönbrunn is simply a must-see.

## 2. WALKING TOUR INCLUDING HOMES OF MOZART AND BEETHOVEN, AND ST. STEPHEN'S CATHEDRAL

We take you on a stroll through the atmospheric old city, seeing selected points of interest. You will discover some of the delightful features of Vienna and visit parts of the city only a true Viennese can point out.

One of the many special highlights is St. Stephen's Cathedral, the finest Gothic structure in Austria. It boasts a high Gothic choir and a late Gothic nave with a steeply pitched roof and decorative glazed tiles. The regularly tapering south tower, popularly known as "Steffl", is Vienna's principal landmark. Major state services are held here, and Mozart's funeral took place here.

Mozarthaus Vienna : Though Mozart lived at a dozen different addresses in Vienna, the only apartment that has survived to this day is at Domgasse No. 5. The composer lived at this address from 1784 till 1787. Occupying 1,000 square meters on six levels, the Mozarthaus was opened on January 27, 2006 – the 250th anniversary of Mozart's birth. Visitors are immersed in the vibrant world of Mozart, experiencing his bountiful genius and creativity, his family, and his friends and foes in Vienna of the late baroque. His apartment on the first floor had four large rooms, two small ones and a kitchen. Throughout his life, Mozart attached great importance to outward appearances: only smart clothes and buckled shoes would suit him.



## 3. SALZBURG CITY TOUR

We take you on a stroll through the old city, seeing selected points of interest. Accompanied by your guides, you will discover the most important sights of Salzburg. The Mirabell Palace, built by Archbishop Wolf Dietrich for his beloved Salome Alt in 1606, now seat of the mayor of Salzburg with the beautiful “Marmorsaal” (marble hall) and the location of weddings and numerous concerts.

Other highlights will be the Landestheater, the Mozarteum and, naturally, Mozart’s House (where the Mozart family lived). By crossing the bridge over the river Salzach, we enter the old part of the city. Walking through the Getreidegasse, the famous traditional shopping mall, we reach Mozart’s birthplace. After a visit to the museum, we proceed to the Cathedral, an imposing early baroque church, and then over Residenz Square, where we learn about the former residence of the Archbishops, nowadays open to the public as a gallery. Afterwards, our guides leave you in the city where you have time to enjoy the great shopping opportunities Salzburg offers or to relax in one of the famous cafes.

## 4. \*OPTIONAL MOZART’S BIRTHPLACE, SALZBURG

This bus tour will take you to see Mozart’s birth house. Salzburg’s most famous son came into this world on 27 January 1756. His family actually lived here for 26 years, from 1747 on, occupying an apartment on the third floor. With parents Leopold and Anna Maria as well as sister “Nannerl”, Mozart spent his childhood and much of his youth there. In 1773, the family moved to the house we know today as the “Mozart Residence”, standing on Makartplatz Square.

Please note that this registration method is for individual participants only, not connected to a registering group. Deposit/Document schedules are firm and all payments and all required MidAm International documents must be received by MidAm by the deposit/document deadline. MidAm retains the right to cancel for non-payment, without refund, if the deposit schedule is not met. Therefore, if any delay in payment or required MidAm document is anticipated, the individual must contact MidAm prior to the payment deadline. Additionally, if an individual's deposit is not received by the deposit deadline (and MidAm does not cancel their registration immediately), an additional \$25 late fee will be added to their past due deposit. An additional \$25 late fee will be added for each additional week that passes following the original deposit deadline if the deposit remains unpaid.

As noted on pages 2 and 3, the total cost is \$4,950 per person for a single occupancy room. This includes events, accommodations, transfers, and all local taxes, gratuities (excluding tips for guides and bus drivers), and Value Added Taxes (VAT) described in the day-to-day itinerary and specifically itemized on the "inclusions" page. This price does not include airfare to Stockholm.

For twin, double or triple occupancy, all roommates must notify the Manager of Operations for MidAm, Madison Zahorsky, at [mzahorsky@midamerica-music.com](mailto:mzahorsky@midamerica-music.com) by **January 15, 2026** in order to have their occupancy type changed. Note that all rooms are "double" size and if a third bed is put in, it may be a cot or convertible/pull-out sofa; furthermore, the room is not larger than a standard double room. Spouses, friends, and families are welcome to be part of the residency. The same package described here applies to them as well.

Your online Concert registration must be completed in order to make your first deposit. All payments must be submitted through the individual registration website. Please complete your registration and follow all instructions for paying via ACH or Credit Card. If your residency should be cancelled by MidAm International (with exception of cancellations made due to late or non-payment), all monies are completely and immediately refundable.

# 2026 Austria Form Information

## Room Grid and Room List:

**Room Grid:** Indicates your occupancy type (if different from single occupancy). For twin, double, or triple occupancy, all roommates must notify the Manager of Operations for MidAm, Madison Zahorsky, at [mzahorsky@midamerica-music.com](mailto:mzahorsky@midamerica-music.com) by **January 15, 2026** in order to have their occupancy type changed. Triple occupancy is limited based on availability.

**Room List:** Includes participant's full legal name, date of birth, passport number, passport expiration date, nationality, passport origin country, cell phone number, dietary restrictions, and mobility restrictions.

## Flight List:

Indicates flight information including airline, flight number, date, and time for both arrival and departure. Please do not purchase any airfare without getting a "go ahead" from MidAm International.

**\*A valid passport is required to enter Austria and the European Union. All travelers (U.S. citizen or non-U.S. citizen) should inquire with the appropriate embassy or consulate regarding entry requirements to Austria.**

# Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1

## **For choral concerts, is it required that music be prepared prior to arrival?**

Yes. Chorus members who are not thoroughly prepared will not be allowed to rehearse or perform in the concert.

## **When will we know the schedule for our residency?**

Schedules (and rehearsal locations) are published 45 days in advance of your arrival. Please refer to the general residency schedule contained in this document for approximate rehearsal and tour times.

## **When can we purchase air tickets and other reservations?**

It is essential and critical that all individuals wait until they receive written confirmation and a “go-ahead” from MidAm International before making any flight arrangements. This will occur after registrations have been received and the concert is confirmed.

## **What size audience can we expect at our concert?**

Audiences are large and enthusiastic. MidAm International has a comprehensive public relations and audience development division that typically sees the vast majority of our international concerts sold out by concert time.

## **How are the concerts promoted and advertised?**

Concerts are promoted extensively through local press and social media, along with hundreds of public and private business sources in each European location. This coverage, as well as efforts for press coverage in ensembles’ home locations are led by Andrea Niederman, our Director of Public Relations, Publications, and Audience Development and her team.

## 2026Austria Residency Terms & Conditions (page 1/1):

### Deposits and Refunds

If your residency should be cancelled by MidAm International (with exception of cancellations made due to late or non-payment), all monies are completely and immediately refundable. This applies to any individual who has made any payments. Deposit/Document schedules are firm and all payments and all required MidAm documents must be received by MidAm International by the deposit/document deadline. MidAm International retains the right to cancel for non-payment, without refund, if the deposit schedule is not met. Therefore, if any delay in payment or required MidAm document is anticipated, the individual must contact MidAm prior to the payment deadline. Additionally, if a deposit is not received by the deposit deadline (and MidAm International does not cancel their registration immediately), an additional \$25 late fee will be added to their past-due deposit. An additional \$25 late fee will be added for each additional week that passes following the original deposit deadline if the deposit remains unpaid.

### Substitutions and Travel Insurance

**Once received, all payments made to MidAm International are non-refundable.** This applies to any individual who has made any payments. Therefore, cancellation insurance is strongly recommended. MidAm International does not endorse or recommend any travel insurance company who might provide such insurance to the ensemble. Please investigate thoroughly through your preferred insurance carrier **prior to** your initial deposit.

### Airfare

Airfare to and from your international residency destination are the responsibility of individuals. If your air arrival is at an alternate airport, you need to arrange transport to the residency city at your own cost. Please consult with your personal travel agent and do your own research on the internet for the best possible price. Please **do not** purchase anything without getting a "go ahead" from MidAm International. **A valid passport is required to enter the European Union or Austria. All travelers (U.S. citizen or non-U.S. citizen) should inquire with the appropriate embassy or consulate regarding entry requirements to Austria.**

### Participant Responsibility

MidAmerica Productions Inc. and MidAm International, Inc. shall not be liable to any individual registrant for any injuries, losses, or expenses suffered or incurred by any individual registrant arising out of or relating to your purchase of this package. All registrants shall maintain appropriate and adequate general liability insurance coverage and any workmen's compensation insurance required by applicable state law. If not already covered by medical insurance registrants are strongly advised to obtain adequate travel medical insurance that covers the duration of their travel. It is the responsibility of all persons participating as performers to arrive on time and be fully prepared for all rehearsals as well as the performance. All individuals in the package must undertake at their own expense to comply with all dress and health requirements of governmental entities as well as the venues where the performance and other events are being held. Should these parameters not be met, MidAm retains the right to disallow those individuals from participating in the rehearsal and/or performance.

### Force Majeure

If the specified venue is unavailable for your performance due to "acts of God" (force majeure), MidAm International, Inc., reserves the right to move this performance to another concert location within the residency city, or if such move is not practicable for reasons beyond the control of MidAm International, Inc., then MidAm International, Inc. shall be relieved from such obligation. Acts of God (force majeure) shall include any unexpected act or circumstance that prevents or impedes MidAm from performing one or more of its contractual obligations if such impediment to MidAm's performance is beyond MidAm's reasonable control and the effects of such impediment cannot reasonably have been avoided or overcome by MidAm. For purposes of this provision, Acts of God shall include, but are not limited to: a) war (whether declared or not), hostilities, act of foreign enemies, b) civil war, riot, rebellion and revolution, act of terrorism, sabotage or piracy; c) currency and trade restriction, embargo, sanction; d) act of authority whether lawful or unlawful, compliance with any law or governmental order, expropriation, seizure of works, requisition, nationalization; e) plague, epidemic (including a recurrence of COVID-19 pandemic), natural disaster or extreme natural event; f) explosion, fire, destruction of equipment, prolonged break-down of transport, telecommunication, information system or energy; g) and general labor disturbance. In the event that "force majeure" causes the cancellation of this tour prior to departure or at any time after arrival in Sweden monies sent to MidAm International are nonrefundable.
